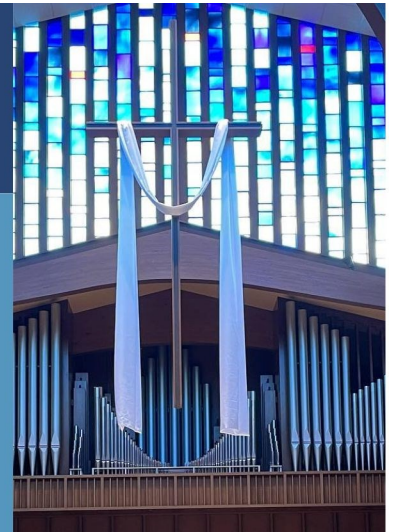

CONFIRMATION CLASS 2024

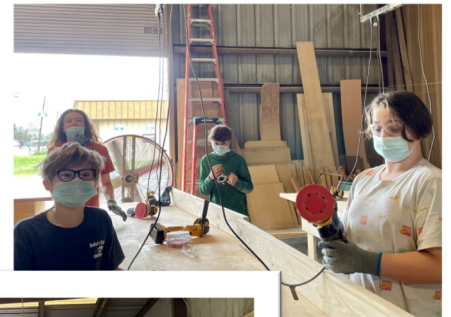
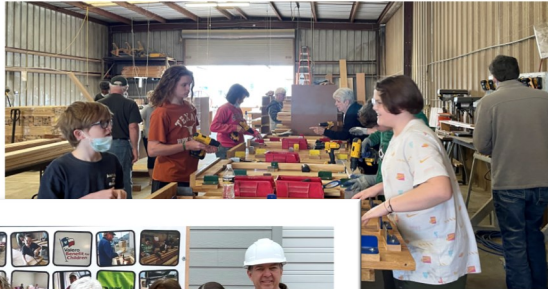
