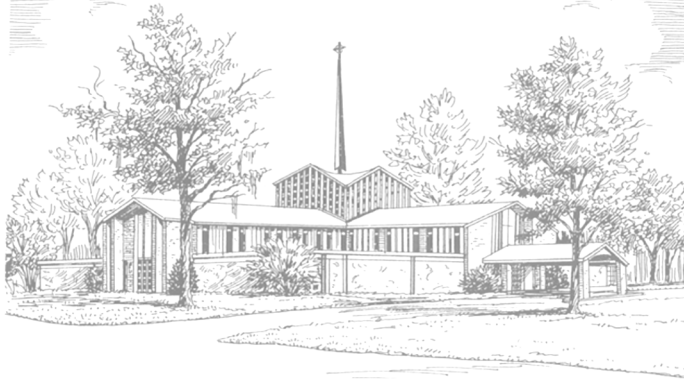

John the Apostle is often thought of as John the Beloved. He was close to Jesus from the time he was called from his fishing nets to be Jesus's disciple to his exile of the island of Patmos. He was said to be younger than Jesus by ten years and lived to be into his 90s. So, his life spanned the first century of the Christian era. His writing lives on today in the fourth gospel, some accounts in Acts, the entire book of Revelation, and in a simple letter we know as I John about love, belief and community. For the next seven weeks we will be reading and studying verse by verse about how to apply that message to our lives today.
