THE SESSION WILL REEVALUATE: by March 8 and then update you on the plans for opening our church for worship, etc.

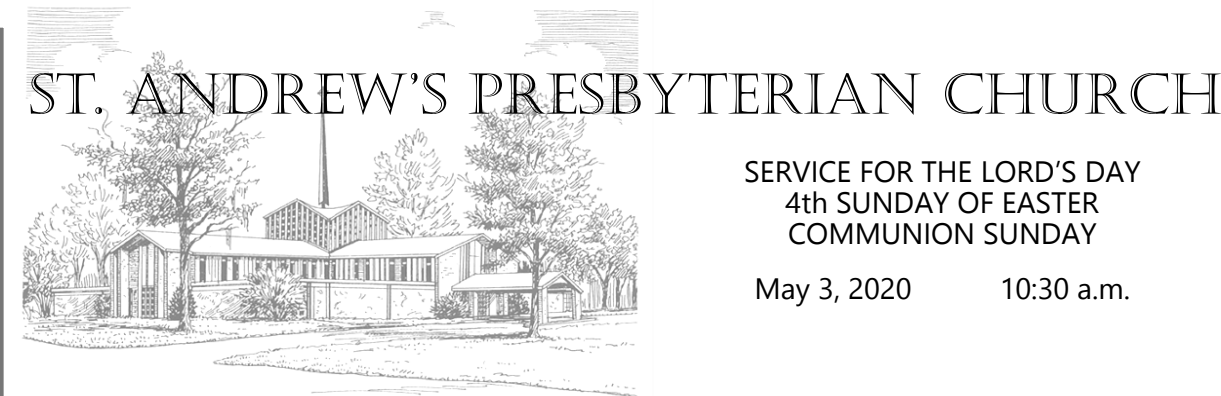
