JUNE 14TH WAS OUR FIRST SUNDAY BACK IN THE SANCTUARY - LIVE: It has been such a blessing to be in worship as church family and friends. Thanks to each of you for following our safety guidelines below. Keep in mind that God is our audience! All Glory to God!

COMMUNION PROCESS TODAY: Communion is served from 3 rolling carts, each manned by 2 masked and gloved servers. On the cart are pre-filled juice cups, pieces of bread, and plates. The server will put the juice cup or cups on the plate and using tongs, place the right amount of bread on the plate. The server will give out the plate or hold it as needed. The recipient may leave the plate and cup on the pew seat and in cup holders or just hand them back to the server who places it on the bottom tray of cart (Note: Gluten free bread is available from each cart). The 3 carts are rolled down the two side aisles of the Nave and the center aisle. The carts and servers from the side aisles will proceed to the Nursery side and the Gladys Street side of the sanctuary to complete the serving.
